Step One: Overview

Take 10-15 minutes and respond to the following prompt. Don't worry too much about sentence structure or form, just write without stopping as much as you are able in the allotted time.

If the goal/project you detail in your diagnosis (PD4) were to be realized, how would it transform the ecological, economic, and social systems of a future world?

Step Two: World Drafting

Now that you have drafted an initial overview of the transformation the goal you discussed would visit on the earth, and listened to [N.K. Jemisin's master class in world building](#), you are ready to begin world building.

To begin to build a world in which you solve for potential threats to the future of life on earth (ex: carbon emissions, nuclear war, super pathogens, etc.), freewrite in response to the following questions for approx. 5 minutes per question. As above, just write without stopping in response to each question as much as you are able in the allotted time.

1. How would **Nations, Government, and/or Laws** have to be different in a world that had achieved the goal(s) you discussed in your diagnosis (PD4)?
2. How would **Geography, Cities, and/or Infrastructure** have to be different in a world that had achieved the goal(s) you discussed in your diagnosis (PD4)?

3. How would **Interpersonal Relationships** have to be different in a world that had achieved the goal(s) you discussed in your diagnosis (PD4)?

4. How would **Religion, Education, and/or Moral** philosophy have to be different in a world that had achieved the goal(s) you discussed in your diagnosis (PD4)?

5. How would **Technology** have to be different in a world that had achieved the goal(s) you discussed in your diagnosis (PD4)?

6. How would **Economics and/or Labor** have to be different in a world that had achieved the goal(s) you discussed in your diagnosis (PD4)?
